



4 Day Icons of Tasmania

Day 1 - Wednesday - Mt. Field National Park – Bonorong Wildlife Park

Your tour guide will meet you at the reception of the Lenna of Hobart at 8.30 am. Travel to Mount Field National Park- Tasmania's first national park, situated in the heart of the island. The park is filled with one of the tallest tree species on earth, waterfalls and stunning glacier-sculpted landforms. With a little luck you may be able to see a Platypus in one of the forest's streams. Enjoy a rainforest walk to Russell Falls and the Tall Trees, followed by a tasty lunch at a nearby café. Complete the afternoon with a visit to Bonorong Wildlife sanctuary to experience Tasmanian Devils, Wombats, Wallabies, Echidnas, Quolls, and other Tasmanian animals first hand. In the evening enjoy a welcome dinner with your guide at one of Hobart's charming waterfront restaurants.

Day 2 - Thursday - Freycinet NP & East Coast

Depart Hobart early and travel through Tasmania's historic midlands. After enjoying a freshly brewed morning coffee at the well known Ross bakery cross the 'Eastern Tiers' range with its spectacular views. Enjoy a relaxing lunch on the edge of Great Oyster Bay before exploring the unsurpassed beauty of the Freycinet National Park and its spectacular beaches. A return walk to Wineglass Bay lookout is on offer as well as a shorter cliff top walk around the lighthouse at Cape Tourville. Continue with a walk on the white quartz sands of the expansive and often deserted Friendly Beaches. Enjoy a scenic afternoon drive along the beautiful east coast, passing through the sleepy coastal towns of Swansea, Orford and Triabunna, with glimpses of the impressive island peak of Mt Maria. After this full day of impressions enjoy a relaxing evening in Hobart.

Day 3 - FRIDAY - RICHMOND - PORT ARTHUR HISTORIC SITE – TASMAN PENINSULA

Your tour guide will pick you up from your hotel at 8:30 am for a drive through rolling hills and pastures with water views along the way to the spectacular Tasman Peninsula. Stop for morning tea before arriving at the Port Arthur Historic Site – the remains of Tasmania’s famous convict settlement. The site features many attractions and our experienced guide will bring its history alive. We have selected particular buildings on your personal route which enable you to experience the breadth of the Port Arthur story. On the return journey, take some time to explore the Tasman Peninsula with its interesting geology such as Devil’s Kitchen and Tasman Arch. There may be time for a drive through the charming town of Richmond with its immaculate sandstone architecture, a picturesque setting reminiscent of the English countryside. Return to Hobart in the late afternoon.

Day 4 - Saturday - SALAMANCA MARKET - HUON VALLEY WINE & FOOD - MT WELLINGTON

Start the day with a stroll through Hobart's legendary and colourful Salamanca Market, before exploring the Huon Trail. Meander along waterways and secluded beaches, past the coastal towns of Margate, Kettering and Woodbridge, stopping at Grandveve Sheep Cheesery to discover how our local cheeses are made. Lunch will be enjoyed at the Hartzview vineyard with its spectacular mountain views, and then continue this scenic route following the Huon River to Huonville. Stop in at a boutique vineyard to sample their wines and complete the day with a drive to the alpine wilderness of Mt Wellington, the 1270m peak, which provides a dramatic backdrop to the city and offers stunning views over southern Tasmania (weather dependant). Your guide will bid you farewell at your hotel in Hobart.
