Option 1 TASMANIA'S HISTORY & DEVILS

Port Arthur Historic Site, Tasmanian Devil Park and Tasman Peninsula

Pick-up from the cruise ship gates or hotel. Visit Port Arthur Historic Site – the remains of Tasmania's famous convict settlement. The site features many attractions and our experienced guide will bring its history alive. After inspecting the Historic Site we will explore the Tasman Peninsula with its rich colonial history and interesting geology. A stop is included at Eaglehawk Neck. Also visit the Tasmanian Devil Park at nearby Taranna. Lunch and morning tea are included.

Minimum of 7 hours is required.

Includes entry to Port Arthur Historic Site, Tasmanian Devil Park, vehicle charter, morning tea and lunch.

Option 2 TASMANIA'S WILDERNESS & FORESTS

Bonorong Wildlife Park and Mt Field National Park

Pick up from cruise ship gates or hotel. Travel to Bonorong Wildlife Park to experience the Tasmanian Devils, Wombats, Wallabies, Echidnas, Quolls, Koalas and other Tasmanian animals first hand. Afterwards continue to Mount Field National Park with a rainforest walk to Russell Falls, Horseshoe Falls and the Tall Trees. This enchanting walk in Tasmania's pure wilderness is accompanied by a delightful Tasmanian lunch.

Minimum of 6 hours is required.

Includes entry to Bonorong Wildlife Park, National Park Passes, vehicle charter, morning tea and lunch.

Option 3 TASMANIA'S FINE FOOD & WINE

Mt Wellington & Huon Valley Food & Wine

Pick up from cruise ship gates or hotel. Depart for Mt Wellington (1270 m) for stunning views over southern Tasmania (weather dependant). Then continue along the Huon Trail for a day of exploring fine food and wine. First stop is the Grandvewe Sheep Cheesery to discover how our local cheeses are made. This is followed by a stroll through charming Woodbridge and lunch at the Hartzview vineyard with its spectacular mountain views . Continue via Cygnet to Huonville and complete the afternoon with a tasting at Home Hill Winery.



Minimum of 7 hours is required.

Includes, wine and cheese tastings, vehicle charter, morning tea and Tasmanian lunch.
